- Has the patient failed or been intolerant to at least 2 different migraine prophylactic therapies, or are all migraine prophylactic therapies contraindicated for the patient? Y N
- Given the potential for medication overuse headache when triptan drugs are used with increased frequency, has the possibility that the patient is experiencing medication overuse headache been considered and ruled out? Y N
- Is the patient taking this medication in combination with another triptan (e.g., Alsuma, Amerge, Axert, Frova, Imitrex, Maxalt, Relpax, Sumavel, Treximet, or Zomig) or an ergotamine-containing drug (e.g., Migranal, Cafergot)? Y N
