Number	Description
1	LOOP 2010AA (Billing provider information)
2	LOOP 2010BA (Pay-to-provider information)
3	FED. TAX NO. (Nine-byte EIN)
4	NPI (Ten-byte facility NPI number)
5	ATTENDING (Physician's 10-byte NPI number)

- 1 Enter Billing provider information (Name, NPI, Address, City/State/ZIP) (2010AA; Enter 'XX' in the NM108 data element to indicate an NPI is present in NM109)
- 2 Enter Pay-to-provider information (Name, Address, City/State/ZIP) (2010BA)
- 3 After mandate, providers should use the nine-byte EIN only when filing to BlueCross BlueShield of South Carolina
- 4 Report 10-byte facility NPI number (2010AA; Enter 'XX' in the NM108 data element to indicate an NPI is present in NM109)
- 5 For fields, 76-79, NPI should be reported when applicable using the physician's 10-byte NPI number (Attending = 2310A; Operating = 2310B; Other = 2310C)
