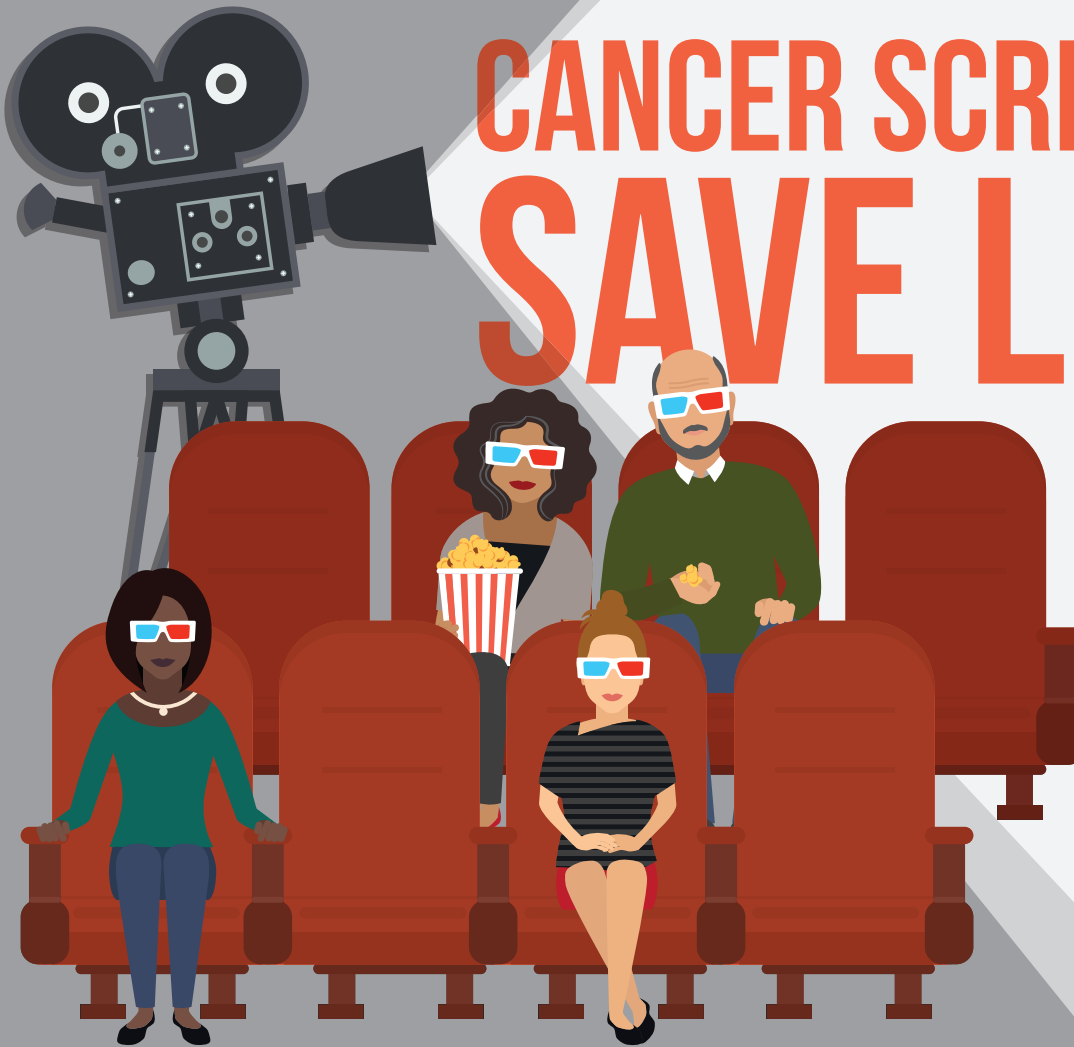


CANCER SCREENINGS SAVE LIVES
